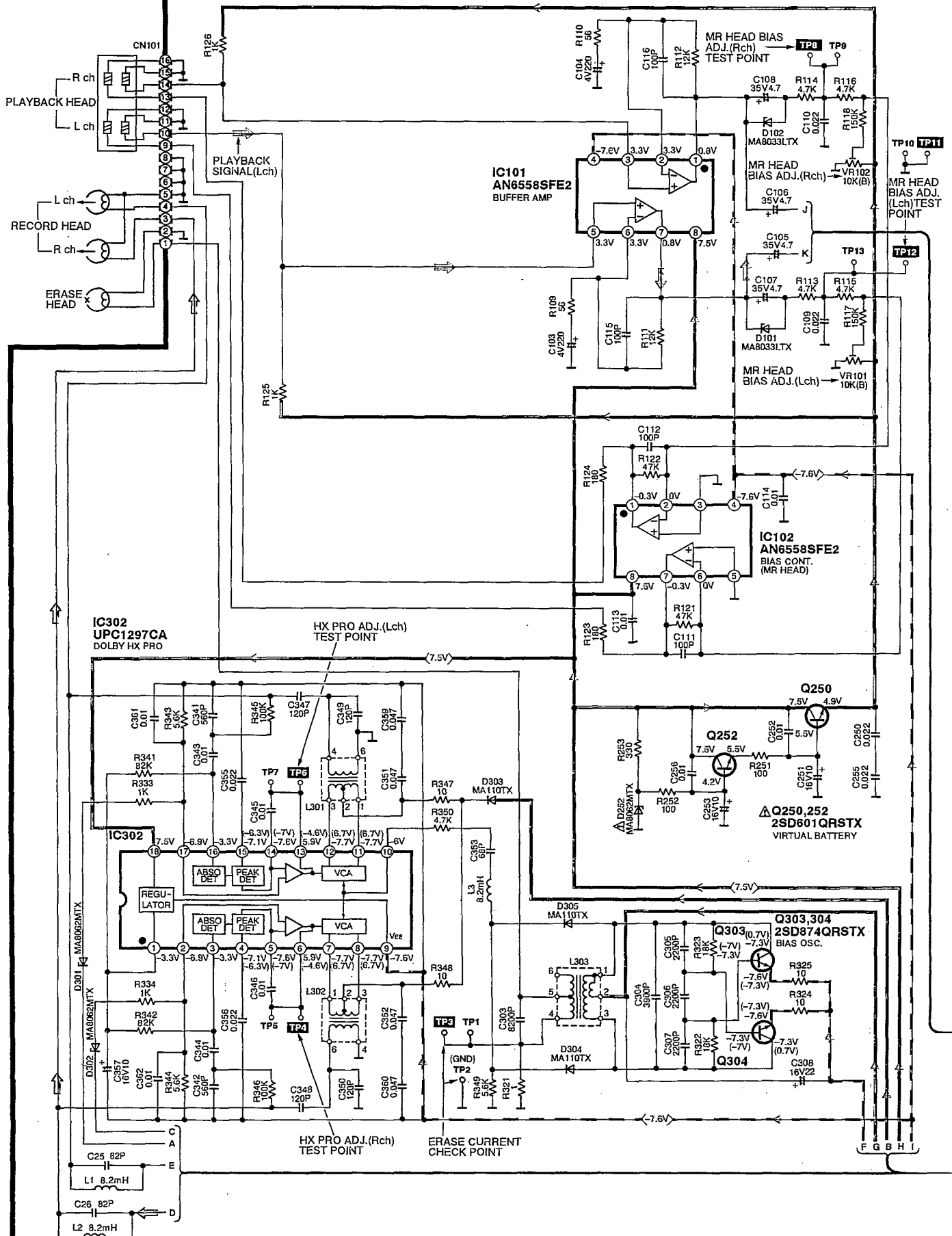
- Cover the parts boxes made of plastics with aluminum foil.

A MAIN CIRCUIT (P.C.Board: on page 18)





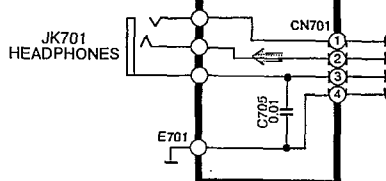


C MOTOR CIRCUIT (P.C.Board: on page 16)


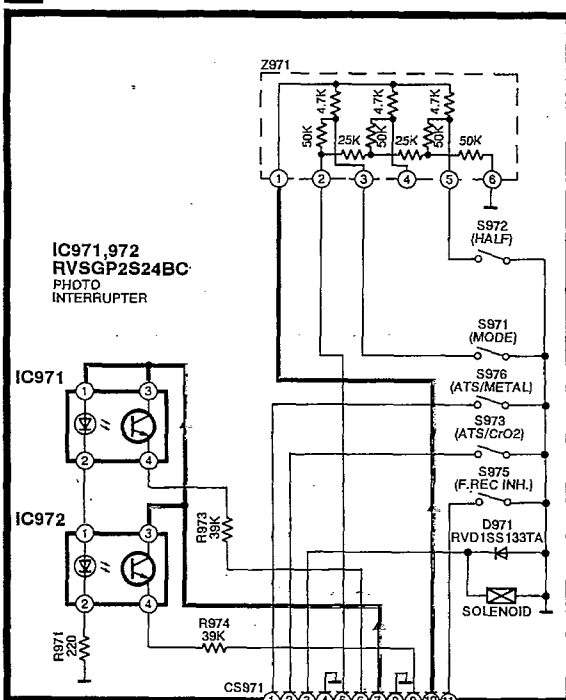
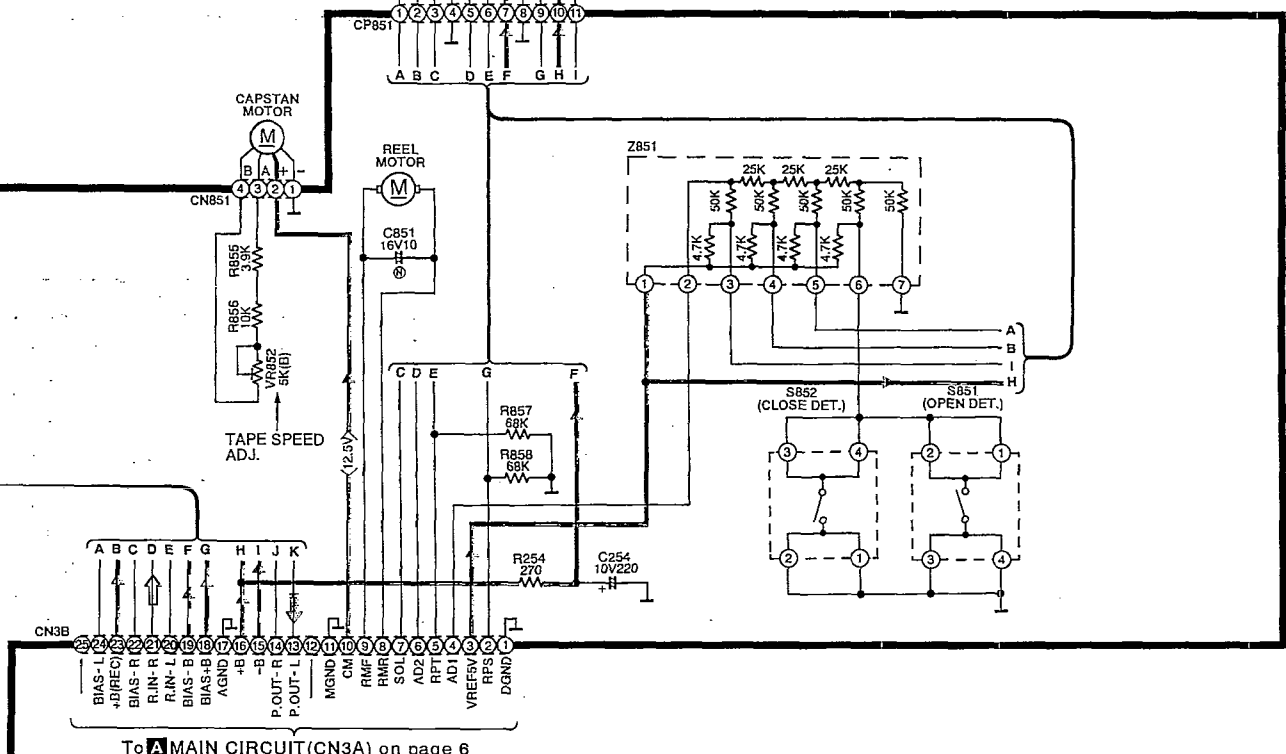
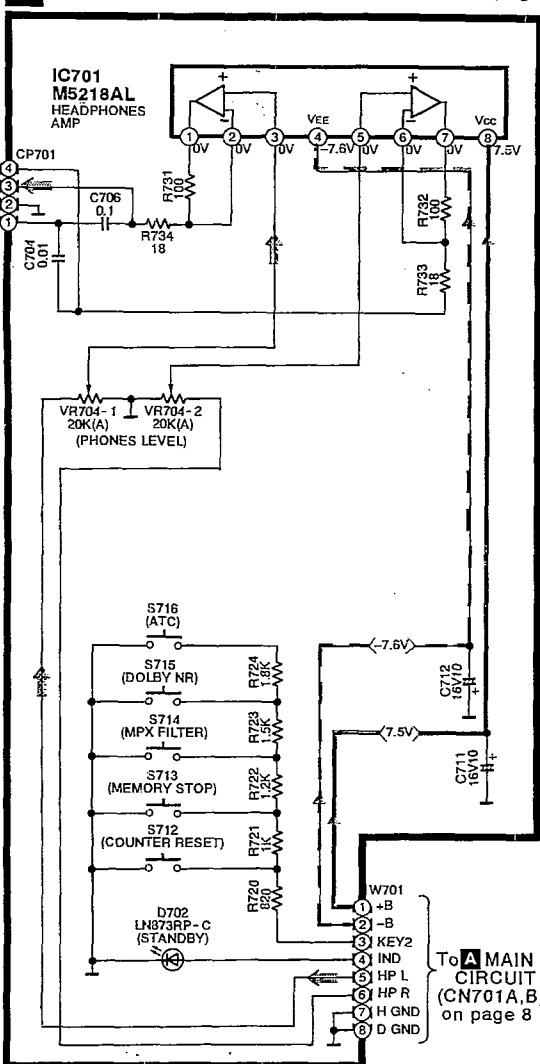
F OPERATION CIRCUIT (P.C.Board: on page 17)

HEADPHONES JACK CIRCUIT

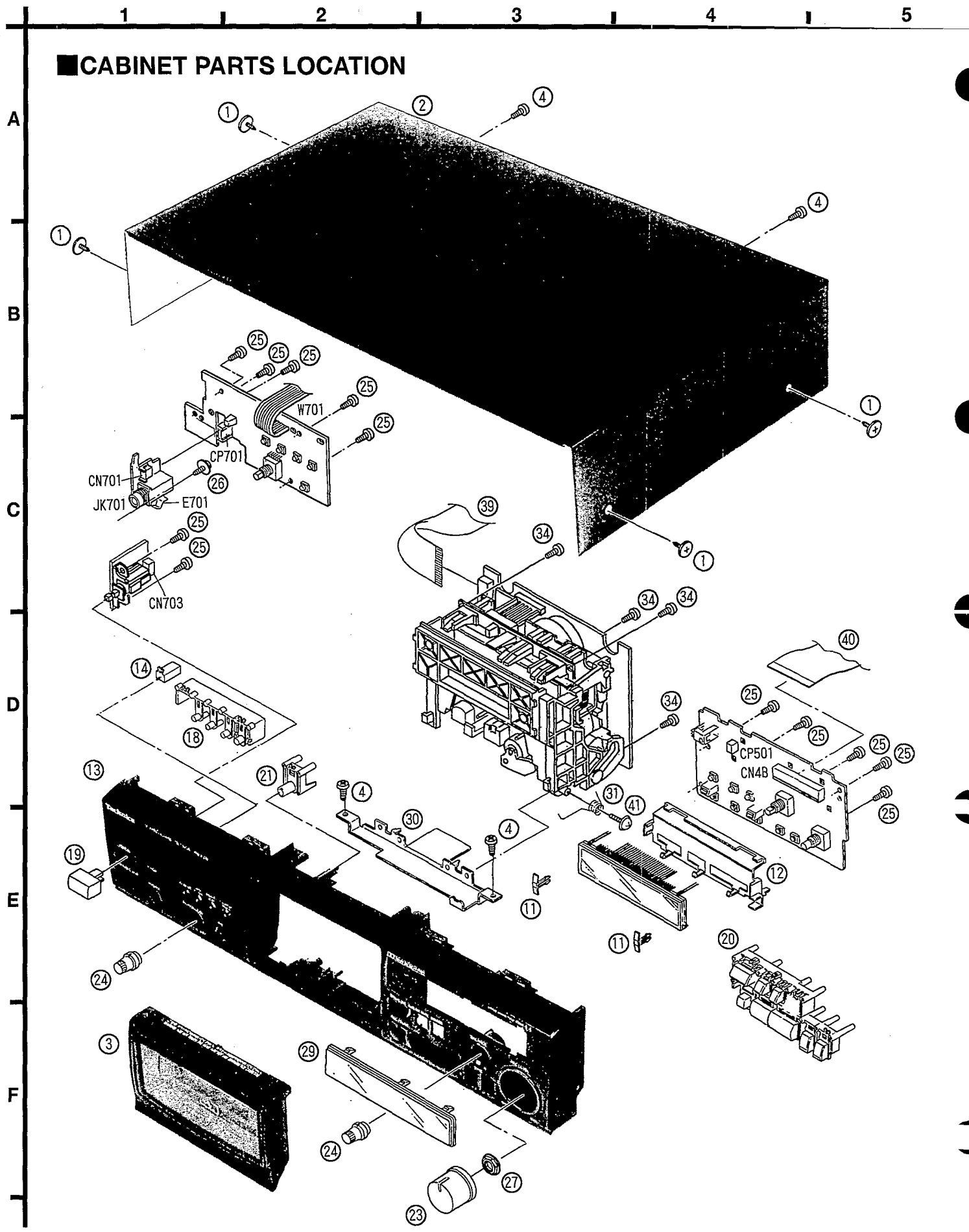

D MECHANISM CIRCUIT (P.C.Board: on page 16)

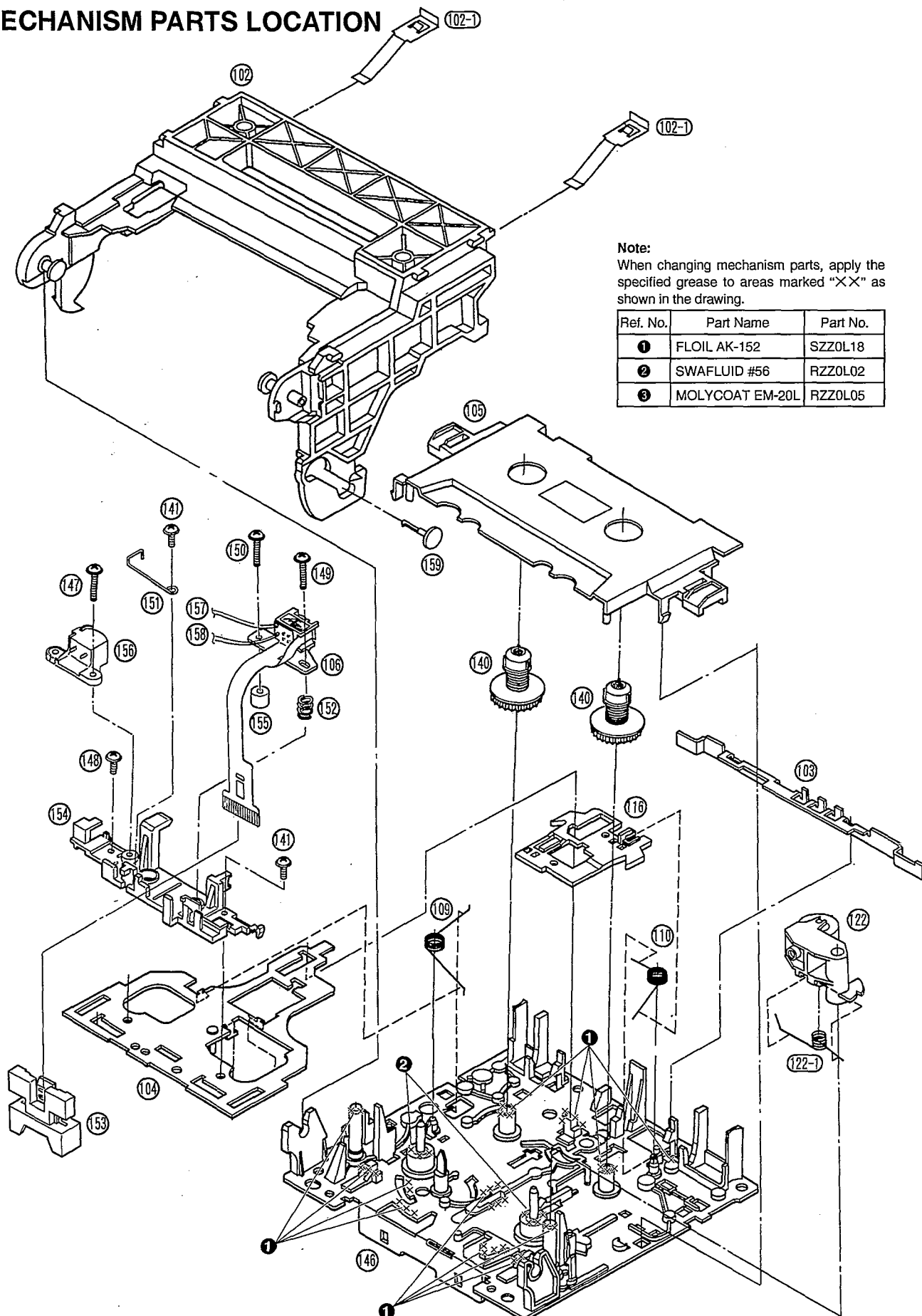
**F** OPERATION CIRCUIT (P.C.Board: on page 17)







MECHANISM PARTS LOCATION



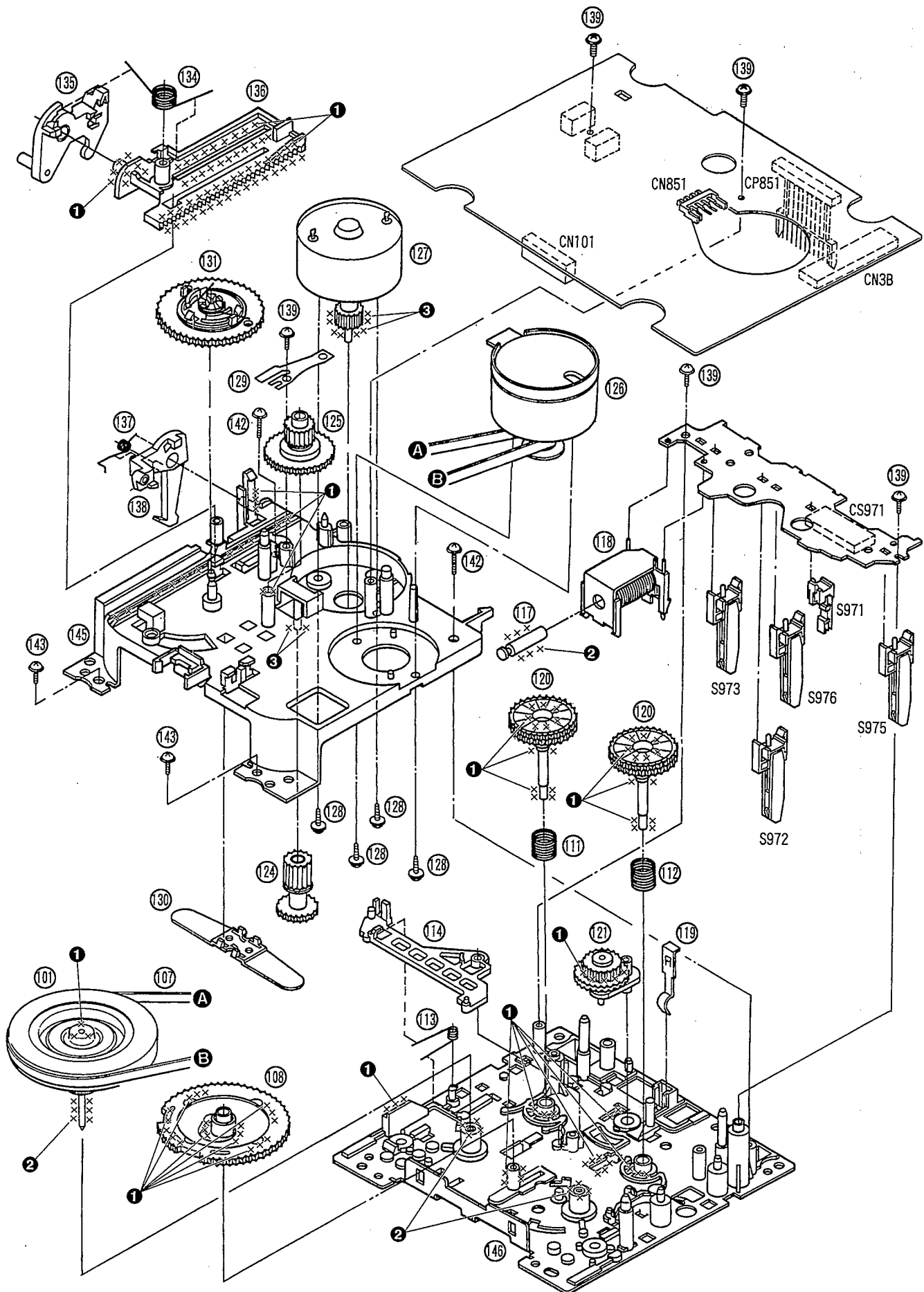
